Genus & Species:	<i>Geranium pratense</i> (Code: TCN-10)
Protection Status:	Rights Asserted
Hardiness:	USDA Zone 5. (-20°F or -28°C).
Bloom:	Vibrant deep flowers with elegant veining. Flowers up to 4cm in diameter.
Bloom Period:	May - June. Second flowering: August - September.
Foliage:	Elegant heavily cut dark colored foliage. Color phasing from early spring.
Habit:	Tidy rounded habit. 24" x 24" at maturity.
Propagation:	Tissue Culture. <i>License will be required for propagation.</i>
Culture:	Full sun – partial shade, well-drained soil.
Additional Comments:	Drought tolerant once established. Exhibits good mildew resistant.
Uses:	Containers, garden borders and landscape plantings.

Approximate Finishing Time

1 Gallon: 16-24 weeks

Comparison: G. Midnight Reiter

- ✓ 'Storm Cloud' large flower up to 4cm **vs.** smaller flowers 2-3cm.
