Genus & Species:	<i>Hedera canariensis</i>
Protection Status:	PP 34,168

Bloom:	Foliage selection.
Bloom Period:	Foliage selection.
Foliage:	Large glossy foliage 3-4" wide by 5-6" long. Unique highly variegated leaves, gold to pure white marbling and flecking. Bright colorful pink new stems.
Habit:	Evergreen climber or efficient ground cover. Species Ultimately 15-20' x 20-60'.
Propagation:	Softwood Cuttings. <i>License required for propagation.</i>
Culture:	Happy in sun to full shade, in any soil that is not waterlogged.
Additional Comments:	Trim when young to encourage strong basal branching.
Uses:	House plant, ground cover, seasonal containers, baskets and mass landscape planting.

1 Gallon:	10-12 weeks
2 Gallon:	12-16 weeks
